


Robust, versatile and tireless the T 9.3 tank locomotive from PIKO!



The T 9.3 tender locomotives, which were used in front of both passenger and freight trains, became one of the most produced locomotives in Germany with their top speed of 65 km/h. From 1901, the Prussian State Railway purchased more than 2,000 vehicles from the Königsberg Union Foundry and the German Reichsbahn in Alsace-Lorraine also ordered 132 units. In 1925, the DR took over the majority of the locomotives into its fleet and classified them as class 91, whereby some machines from Belgium were also included under this designation. During the Second World War, individual machines were sent to Poland and Austria, among others. After 1945, the locomotives were gradually withdrawn from scheduled service in Germany and were therefore no longer to be found on the DB in 1964 and on the DR in 1971.
